

Dermatovenerology

A dermatovenerologist or dermatologist specialises in the diagnosis, treatment and monitoring of various skin and sexually transmitted diseases.

For the purpose of diagnosis and treatment, we perform several dermatological procedures: various minor surgeries (removal of skin formations), skin biopsies, cryotherapy or freezing therapy, diathermocoagulations to remove haemangiomas.

In addition, we perform diagnostics of various skin formations and dermatoscopy, which allows us to diagnose atypical moles and new skin formations. Dermatoscopy allows early detection of skin changes, including melanoma.
