In-patient fee

Patients undergoing inpatient treatment must pay a bed-day fee of **2.5 euros** for each calendar day that has started but no more than 10 calendar days per illness. When a patient is transferred from a hospital's medical department to a hospital's rehabilitation department, a new medical case is started.

The bed-day fee is not charged in following cases:

- · For patients without national health insurance cover
- · Upon provision of in-patient specialised medical care related to pregnancy or delivery
- Upon provision of in-patient specialised medical care to a person younger than 19 years of age
- · For a period when intensive care is provided
- · Upon provision of day care and day surgery services
- Upon provision of an independent in-patient nursing service
- · Upon provision of in-patient rehabilitation that is subject to cost-sharing
- · Upon provision of paid in-patient health services
- Upon provision of in-patient chemotherapy
- In the case of repeated admissions up to 30 days after the end of the first hospitalisation if the repeated hospitalisation is caused by a complication that occurred at East Tallinn Central Hospital
- · For hospital stays for a caregiver of a child of under one year of age
- In the event of the patient's death during hospitalisation

The independent in-patient nursing care self-financing fee is **21,79 euros** per bed day.

You can pay the bed-day fee in cash or by card at all hospital reception desks. In exceptional cases, the bill can also be paid by bank transfer or in our <u>patient portal iPatsient</u>.

If the payment deadline is exceeded, we will send you a reminder. If payment is not received, we have the right to assign the claim to a company providing debt collection services. To avoid any inconvenience, please pay all of your invoices on time.

The bed-day fee is established on the basis of <u>§71 of the Health Insurance Act</u> by the decision of the Board of East Tallinn Central Hospital on 18 February 2013.
